



Tract (5-15) Gravey South Sale




Select Cut Area (111 acres) -Bounded by red paint line, Hines Grade, and Carlson Road. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1)snags 2)cull trees 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only **marked** aspen.




Spruce Plantation (5 acres)- Bounded by red paint line and Carlson Road. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Cut only **marked** aspen.




Aspen/Red Maple/Spruce Area (40 acres) – Bounded by yellow paint, Hines Grade, and Carlson Road. Harvest all trees greater than 2 inches **except for:** 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3)oak,4)cherry.



Tamarack Seed Tree Area (1 acre) - Bounded by green paint. Harvest all trees greater than 2 inches **except for:** 1) hemlock 2) white pine, 3)green marked trees.

MX¹ pulp volume includes 43% hard maple, 34% red maple, 10% ash, 8% yellow birch, and 5% ironwood, elm, white birch and cherry combined.

MX² includes 5 MBF red maple, 3MBF basswood, and 2 MBF yellow birch.

*Other species not mentioned will be charged at the mixed pulp or Mixed saw price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately two years.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut or plantation areas.
3. Existing woods roads will be used and proposed roads may be built. Decking will be permitted along woods roads and forest roads. Any decking of wood along Carlson Road or Hines Grade shall be located outside of ditch line such that it won't impede traffic.
4. Slash that is within 100 feet of Carlson Road or Hines Grade shall be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground.
5. Carlson Road and a portion of Hines Grade are ATV/snowmobile trail, 3" of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting.
6. Contractor is required to close road at the locations designated on the map by placing logging debris, per sale prospectus.
7. All logging debris shall be kept off of and out of the ditch lines of Hines Grade and Carlson Road. All slash and ends will be removed from snowmobile trail and Hines Grade and ditches concurrently with each truckload.
8. There are steep slopes and wet areas within this sale that will cause equipment limitations. There is an esker that runs from the south end of the sale to the north end.
9. Use of continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the select cut area due to varying density and distribution of regeneration.
10. **All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.**
