

# Tract 9-15 (North Fork Road Sale)



**Select Cut (9 acres)** - Bounded by red paint. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1) snags, 2) cull trees, 3) trees marked with an orange X. Trees near river are only marked on one side.



**Aspen Area (24 acres)** - Bounded by yellow paint and blue paint lines. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) white pine, 3) oak, 4) spruce or balsam fir with less than 2 sticks.



**White Pine Area (32 acres)** - Bounded by red paint (eastern stand) or yellow paint (western stand). Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) hemlock, 2) oak, 3) spruce and balsam fir with less than 2 sticks, 4) unmarked white pine. Only cut white pine with orange paint. Do not damage white pine seedlings or saplings. Run over/shear hazel, ironwood, and musclemwood.




**Tamarack Seed Tree (4 acres)** - Bounded by green paint. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) white pine, 2) hemlock, 3) trees marked with a green X.



**White Birch Seed Tree (4 acres)** - Bounded by green paint and blue paint lines. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) white pine, 2) hemlock, 3) oak, 4) trees marked with a green X.

<sup>1</sup>Mixed pulp includes approx. 16% of sugar maple, 77% of red maple, 6% of yellow birch, and 1% swamp white oak, ash, and ironwood. Mixed pulp also includes approx. 500 board feet of red maple. White birch includes 1.5 MBF of saw. <sup>3</sup>Balsam fir includes 40% balsam, 30% white spruce, 10% black spruce, and 20% tamarack. <sup>4</sup>White pine includes 38 MBF of saw. Other species not mentioned will be charged the mixed pulp price.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately two years.

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. The select cut area, white birch area, and the western white pine area are in the Flambeau River Scenic Management Area. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen conditions between October 15<sup>th</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>. The aspen area, tamarack area, and the eastern white pine area will be restricted to very dry or frozen conditions. Areas with drainages will require frozen conditions. No cutting can be done during the months of April, May and June except in the aspen area.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut areas or the white pine areas.
3. Turnarounds must be approved by Forester. Opening may be used for turnaround.
4. New road construction is limited to proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Modifications can be made with approval from Forester.
5. Any decking on North Fork Road must have prior approval from Flambeau Township. If permission is granted from Flambeau Township, all slash and ends will be removed from the road and ditches concurrently with each truckload.
6. Slash that is within 100 feet of North Fork Road and Hwy 70 will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor.
7. No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private.
8. Contractor is required to berm all new roads by placing logging debris, per sale prospectus.
9. Avoid government survey monuments illustrated on prospectus map.
10. All wood located within the Flambeau River Scenic Management Area shall be removed prior to April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
11. Cutting will not be allowed in the white birch seed tree areas or white pine areas until scarification is completed by the State during non-frozen conditions. Harvest shall be completed within one year of scarification.
12. Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in areas with northern hardwood regeneration or white pine regeneration.
