Minimum Acceptable Bid for Entire Sale: \$26,635.00

Note: Bid bond not required. Winning bidders will have 6 weeks from the date of the bid opening to submit an acceptable performance bond to the department. The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. If the winning bidder fails to execute the contract and submit an acceptable performance bond, the bidder shall be required to forfeit to the department an amount equal to 10% of the total bid amount. Failure to forfeit the 10% penalty will result in the bidder being considered ineligible to bid on any state timber sales for a two-year period. Contract length will be two years.

General Sale Conditions

- Harvest areas are bounded by yellow paint line.
- Best access to sale area is through private land off the end of Up River Rd. It is the responsibility of the contractor to secure access with private party.
- Harvesting in forested wetlands will be conducted under frozen ground conditions.
- Roads will be returned to as good or better condition following sale completion.
- Rutting policy will be enforced per contract.

- 1). **Coppice Regeneration Harvest (53 acres)-** Cut all stems greater than 2” DBH except for hemlock, pine, and any trees marked in blue paint.
- 2). **Selection Harvest (7 acres)-** Cut all stems marked in orange paint and all aspen, balsam, and ironwood containing 1 or more 100 inch pulpsticks.
- 3). **Seed Tree Harvest (3 acres)-** Cut all stems greater than 2” DBH except for pine and any trees marked with blue paint.
