




Tract (5-16) Whistling Hardwoods Sale




Select Cut Area (145 acres) - Bounded by red paint line and hunter walking trail. Harvest all orange marked trees within the designated boundaries. Sever all orange marked unmerchantable stems (canopy gaps). Leave, do not cut 1)snags 2)cull trees 3) trees marked with an orange X. Cut only marked aspen. Cut all balsam fir with 2 sticks or more and merchantable ironwood.




Aspen Area (6 acres) - Bounded by yellow paint line. Cut all trees greater than 2" except for: 1) white pine, 2) oak, 3) cedar, 4) hemlock.



Purple Area (2 acres)- Bounded by purple paint. Cut all trees greater than 1" except for: 1) purple X marked trees, 2) hemlock, 3) white pine, 4) oak.

The performance bond will be 15% of the total sale value. Contract length is approximately **three years**.

SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:

Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions between Dec. 1st and March 31st due to wet soil conditions.

This entire sale is located within a special management unit, harvesting can be conducted between **Dec. 1st - March 31st**.

Use of a continuous rotating saw head will not be allowed in the select cut area due to density and distribution of regeneration.

Motor vehicle access during hunting season (Sept. 15-Dec. 1) shall be for logging purposes only (i.e. road building).

Drainage crossings may need timber mats if adequate snow is not available for fill.

If nearby sales are not completed prior to this sale starting, the hunter walking trail will be used for access for both sales. It is the responsibility of the contractors of each sale to determine the logistics for hauling.

A special management area may need to be designated with logging restrictions between February 1st and August 1st, prior to harvesting on the sale.

All additional restrictions listed in prospectus and standard contract apply unless specified.
