



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The bid bond will be 15% of the total sale value. This will also be used as the performance bond. Contract length is approximately two years.

**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. Equipment use will be restricted to very dry or frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions. General operational period will most likely be December through March, unless special permission is granted during abnormally dry conditions.
2. Road construction will be required; new road construction must be approved by Forester. Roads shall not exceed 15 feet in width without permission from the Forester.
3. Any decking on Rock Creek Road must have prior written approval from Lake Township.
6. No landings will be allowed within 200 ft. of Rock Creek **OR** Rock Creek Road. Landing size will be limited to a maximum size of 100 ft. x 200 ft.
7. Slash that is within 100 feet of Rock Creek will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor. No slash will be left within town road ROW. No slash or logging debris will be left across the blue line onto private land or in Rock Creek.
8. No wheeled or tracked harvesting equipment will be operated within 50 feet of the ordinary high water mark of Rock Creek.
9. Watch for small wetlands throughout the sale.
10. Avoid government survey marker on the north edge of sale, also noted on prospectus map.
11. Public passage on Rock Creek road will be allowed during sale operations.
12. Contractor is required to close roads with logging debris berm upon completion of sale, per sale prospectus.



2. Pole length skidding will be allowed only in aspen areas. Landings will be limited to 100 ft. by 200 ft.
3. New road construction must be approved by Forester.
4. No slash will be left in ditches of Cty Rd W ROW or state forest access road. Slash that is within 100 feet of Cty. Rd. W will be lopped to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor.
5. Caution: This tract borders numerous wetlands with scattered soft spots adjacent to them. Watch for small wetlands throughout the sale.
6. Timber mats or slash shall be utilized temporarily for accessing sale areas at wetland crossings as indicated on map. The timber mats or slash need to be removed promptly when completed in these areas. Placement and removal shall be the responsibility of the contractor.







1. Equipment use will be restricted to **frozen ground conditions only** due to wet soil conditions.
2. No pole length skidding will be allowed in the select cut area, the spruce thinning area, or the tamarack strip cut area.
3. Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction will be necessary to access the sale area. The new road construction is limited to the proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Modifications can be made with approval from Forester. Roads are not to exceed 15 ft. in width without permission from the Forester.





- Existing woods roads will be used. Decking of wood along existing woods roads within the sale area is allowed. New road construction is optional and must be approved by Forester. No new access points will be allowed off of West Lane.
- Landing size will be limited to a maximum size of 100 ft x 200 ft.
- No logging activities** will be allowed from **February 1<sup>st</sup> to August 1<sup>st</sup>**, within the **Special Management Area** shown on the map.






**SPECIAL SALE CONDITIONS:**

1. Equipment use restricted to frozen ground conditions due to wet soil conditions, except for the two red pine plantations marked with a "1". **No rutting allowed.** Although summer logging, during very dry conditions, is permitted in two of the red pine plantations, during wet periods the soils may become soft, and susceptible to rutting and road damage.
2. No pole skidding will be allowed within red pine thinning or select cut area.
3. Existing woods roads will be used. New road construction is optional, and is limited to proposed road layout shown on prospectus map. Due to topography and or drainage patterns new roads must be approved by State Forest staff. Gaining access through the private property is the responsibility of the contractor.
4. No additional access points will be permitted along Hwy W. Access points from Hwy. W are shown with an X. All loaded trucks shall exit pine plantations labeled as "1" on Nedli Road. Loaded trucks shall not exit via Hwy W access.(steep hill and poor visibility)
5. 3" of packed snow will be maintained on snowmobile trail, weather permitting. The trail will be kept free of debris. Public passage by car, atv, and snowmobile will be allowed on Nedli Road during sale operations.
6. No slash will be left in road ROW or within 33 feet of centerline. No slash will be left in the ditch lines of State Forest roads. Slash that is within 100 feet of Hwy W will be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground by the contractor. No slash or logging debris shall be left across the blue lines onto private land.
7. Road approaches to surfaced roads or other government public roads are the responsibility of the Contractor. Damage to these roads is the responsibility of the Contractor. Roads are not to exceed 15 ft. in width without permission from the Forester.
8. Decking will be permitted along existing woods road. Existing landings and existing woods road will be used. Decking will be located off of the snow/atv trail to avoid traffic. The decking of wood will not be allowed within 200 feet of a stream, trail, graded road or county highway. Landing size will not exceed 100' by 200'.
9. Contractor is required to place logging debris berms at designated map locations.






