The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a 4” top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Biomass/whole tree utilization is NOT allowed.

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<sup>1</sup>Contains approximately 240 tons or 42% balsam fir, 240 tons or 42% tamarack and 95 tons or 16% spruce.


<sup>2</sup>Contains approximately 270 tons or 49% white birch (13MBF), 150 tons red maple or 27%, 123 tons hard maple or (22%) and 7 tons basswood or 2%. Included in this volume is approximately 13 MBF of white birch saw-log sized material.

Total sale volume equates to approximately 45 tons/acre or 20 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested including non-merchantable trees when marked.
2. Frozen ground only cutting restriction in the Tamarack stand due to wetland soils.
3. Slash must be lopped and scattered to within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet from property lines and roads.
4. Dead snags shall be left standing, unless they pose an operational safety risk.
5. Biomass harvesting is not allowed due to presence of nutrient poor soils.
6. Soil rutting and damage to residual trees will NOT be tolerated.
7. The snowmobile trail must remain: free of debris, snow covered during winter and in good condition at all times.
8. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
9. Private road (Kriek Ct.) must be kept in good, drivable condition at all times and left in as good or better condition upon completion of sale. Logger and DNR Forester will meet with Krieks to determine best access point. Access not allowed during spring break-up (Jim & Marsha Kriek: h:715-542-3885, c:715-617-3885).
10. Town of St. Germain requires a driveway permit on all new approaches. Contractor is responsible for permits, roadwork and materials required by township.

- Red Pine Thinning (13 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees and balsam fir with one or more pulp sticks.
- Tamarack Clearcut with Reserves (7 Acres): Cut all merchantable trees. Do NOT cut green painted trees or white cedar. Harvest only during frozen ground conditions.
- Birch Shelterwood (16 Acres): Cut all trees 2 inches and larger, Do NOT cut green painted trees, white pine, hemlock, yellow birch or red oak.
- Aspen/White Birch Coppice (3 Acres): Cut all aspen and white birch 2 inches and larger. Cut orange painted trees. Do NOT cut green painted trees, white pine, spruce, hemlock or yellow birch.
