The cutting area is approximately 322 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

² Approximately 61% hard maple, 25% white birch, 12% red maple, and 2% misc. hardwood species. (2.49 tons/cord weighted average)


³ Approximately, 62MBF MH logs, 30MBF BW logs, 12 MBF MR logs and a few miscellaneous species sawlogs.

The total sale volume equates to approximately 13.4 cord equivalents per acre.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested including non-merchantable trees when marked.
2. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
3. Short-wood forwarding only within the entire sale area to avoid ground disturbance and damage to residual trees.
4. No decking will be permitted along town roads without prior approval from the town. Decking is allowed on boat landing parking lot.
5. Slash must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10' behind the tree line along all roads and recreational trails concurrently with cutting.
6. The snowmobile trails must remain free of debris, snow covered during winter, and left in good condition at all times.
7. **Harvesting activity will not be allowed from April 15th to July 15th, in addition Marked HWD/Aspen Mix Stand is only frozen ground operational.**
8. Alternative access can be made through State Forest logging roads to the west to connect to Keuchenmeister Road and Camp 2 Road, Which goes south to CHY K.
9. Many interior woods roads are overgrown and will need to be cut out and leveled to be operational. Pre-approval with sale forester must be done before roadwork begins. The 3 east-west roads are operational now. No travel will be allowed into the research area to the east of the sale boundary.
10. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspections provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

-  MARKED HARDWOOD (234 Acres): Cut all aspen and balsam fir not marked with green paint. Cut only oak, hardwood and pine marked with orange paint. Canopy Gaps are marked with purple banded trees. Purple banded perimeter trees are to remain uncut. All trees interior of the purple banded gap perimeter trees are to be cut including all 1-5" stems.
-  ASPEN MIX (44 Acres): Cut all aspen, hardwood and balsam fir not marked with green paint. Only cut oak and pine marked with orange paint.
-  MARKED HARDWOOD/ASPEN MIX (44 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir and orange marked trees. Harvesting may only take place during frozen ground conditions.

SEASONAL RESTRICTION: No harvesting to take place between April 15 and July 15 for the entire sale area.

The entire sale area lies within Management Area 8 -- Lake Laura Loamy Hills -- Native Community
