Section 20 - NWNE, NENE, SENE, SENW

The cutting area is approximately 32 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.


¹Volume includes approximately 75% White Pine, 11% Red Pine and 14% Fir. Volume estimate includes potential 3 MBF White Pine and 2 MBF Red Pine saw logs.

² Volume includes approximately 51% Red Maple, 19% White Birch, 18% Aspen and 12% Red Oak. Volume estimate includes potential 6 MBF Red Oak and 1MBF White Birch.

Special Conditions:

1. Seasonal Restriction: No harvesting or skidding is allowed between April 15 and July 15 due to risk of oak wilt in oak area.
2. Harvesting will only be allowed when ground is sufficiently dry enough or frozen to prevent rutting.
3. The forest road on the west end of the sale must remain passable at all times for vehicle access and any damage that may occur must be immediately repaired.
4. Biomass Harvesting is not allowed.
5. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
6. All slash is to be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. All slash is to be pulled back so as to not lie within 10 feet of roads, trails or property lines concurrent with cutting.
7. Any landings and new roads must be approved by the DNR administrator.
8. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
9. There will be no cutting activity allowed in the established RMZs between the red lines and Dead Pike Lake and the creek.
