



The objectives for this part of the Forest are to increase the presence and age of red pine and white pine in all timber types. Additional objectives are to manage for limited amounts of aspen and to maintain pine plantations.

The PINE MIX areas are composed of both red pine plantations and older natural stands. Within these stands roughly one-third of the trees will be removed. The majority of the short-lived species will be harvested. This technique will maintain the growth and vigor of the remaining pine and meet the objectives for the area.

The ASPEN MIX areas will be regenerated by harvesting most of the trees within the two blocks. This cut will mimic a natural disturbance and allow the early successional aspen type to be maintained on the landscape. An additional goal of this type of harvest is to increase the age-class diversity of the aspen type within the vicinity. Portions of this stand will naturally convert to longer-lived red and white pine. Year of origin on the aspen type is 1966.

Seasonal restrictions related to oak wilt will be imposed in areas with a significant oak presence. Biomass harvesting will not be allowed due to nutrient poor soils.
