



The objectives for this part of the Forest are to increase the presence and age of red pine and white pine in all timber types. Additionally, the aspen component is to be maintained as a dominant community on the landscape.

The pine areas are composed of both plantation and older natural stands. Within these red pine types roughly one-third of the trees will be harvested. This technique will maintain the growth and vigor of the remaining trees and meet the objectives for the area. Year of origin for the plantations is 1958. Year of origin for the natural pine stands is 1911.

The Birch Mix will have the majority of the short-lived species removed. The understory white pine will be released to aid in the conversion to a longer-lived species within the riparian management zone along the Trout River. Year of origin for the birch stand is 1927.

No seasonal restrictions will be imposed and biomass harvesting will not be allowed due to nutrient poor soils.
