15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 88 acres.

The contract period is 2½ years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.


<sup>1</sup> Contains approximately 1200 tons (23 MBF) sugar maple, 185 tons (28 MBF) basswood, 185 tons white birch, 85 tons (7 MBF) black ash, 68 tons (9 MBF) yellow birch, and 20 tons red maple.

The total sale volume equates to approximately 25.6 tons/acre or 10.9 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. No logging activity allowed between April 1 and September 15.
2. Slash adjacent to the Town Road and the easement road must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
3. Biomass Harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize dead trees unless the tree poses a safety hazard during harvesting operations.
4. Do not operate equipment within 15 feet of wetlands or vernal ponds unless during frozen ground conditions.

- ▬ Northern Hardwood Area (72 Acres): Cut all balsam fir and orange marked trees. Cut all ironwood 2 inches and greater in diameter. Gaps are marked with purple paint. Cut all stems over 1 inch in diameter within the gap. Leave the trees painted purple uncut.
- ▬ Aspen Area (16 Acres): Cut all balsam fir, aspen, white birch and trees marked with orange paint. Cut all trees marked with orange paint only west of the buried powerline in Zone A.

All stands are within Mgmt. Area 9:  
Hemlock/Northern Hardwood -  
Native Community and Mgmt. Area 1:  
Winegar Moraines - Forest Production

**Note: Do NOT cut green marked trees. The first 500 feet of road extending north from Cedar Lake Circle is an easement driveway that must be kept in drivable condition for car traffic at all times.**
