

NH-ALSF TRACT NO. 25-16

Hwy 51 & N

Vilas County

Town 41 North, Range 6 East

Section 25 – NWNE, SWNE, SENE, NESW, NESE, NWSE, GL 1, 2

No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 109 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Whole Tree harvest is allowed.

1 White Pine contains an estimated 225 tons pulp (45% of the 4 inch top volume) and 54 MBF (55%).

2 Red Pine contains an estimated 243 tons pulp (39% of 4 inch top volume) and 69 MBF (61%).

3 Balsam Fir is 54% balsam fir and 46% Norway spruce. (wt. conv 2.068 tons/cord)


4 Mixed Hardwood is 79% red maple, 19% white birch, and 2% hard maple. (wt. conv 2.304 tons/cord)

Note: Total sale volume equates to 43 tons/acre or 19 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
3. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
4. No equipment use allowed in ephemeral ponds or wetlands. Do not deposit slash in wetlands.
5. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

- Pine (76 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple, white birch, and orange marked trees. Cut all 1-5" aspen and maple.
- Spruce (8 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, maple, and orange marked trees.
