No bid bond is required

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 186 acres.

The contract period is 3½ years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.


³ Contains approximately 45 MBF white birch, 45 MBF sugar maple and 10 MBF red maple.

Special Conditions

1. SEASONAL RESTRICTION: No harvest activity allowed between the Friday before Memorial Day through Labor Day. The hauling of cut products will be permitted within this time frame
2. Biomass Harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize dead trees unless the tree poses a safety hazard during harvesting operations.
3. Short-wood forwarding only. Tree length or pole skidding is prohibited.

- Oak/Hardwood Area (178 Acres): Cut all ironwood, white birch and balsam fir. Cut all trees marked with orange paint. Within the canopy gaps (marked by trees painted with purple paint) cut all stems greater than 1 inch.
- Aspen Area (8 Acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, maple and oak. Cut all pine marked with orange paint. Cut all 1 to 5 inch maple.

Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint. DO NOT CUT ANY YELLOW BIRCH.

Seasonal Restriction: No harvest activity allowed between the Friday before Memorial Day through Labor Day. The hauling of cut products will be permitted within this time frame.
