The cutting area is approximately 61 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is allowed.



¹ Mixed hardwood volume includes approximately 56% red maple and 44% white birch.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. All landings require prior approval.
3. All trails and roads must be kept clear of slash and in driveable condition.
4. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees, including understory pine regeneration, must be avoided.
5. Forestry Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be followed adjacent to the wetlands.
 - A. No wheeled or tracked vehicles permitted to operate in the wetland.
 - B. Trees may not be felled into wetland areas.
 - C. No slash shall be deposited into wetland areas.
7. All roads must be returned to their original condition.
8. Biomass harvesting is approved on this sale.

Marked Hardwood Area (22 Acres): Cut all aspen, birch, balsam fir (including 1"-5" stems) and all trees marked with orange paint.



Aspen Regeneration Area (12 Acres): Cut all aspen, birch, balsam fir, and maple (including 1"-5" stems).



Scenic Resources Area (27 Acres): Cut all balsam fir (including 1"-5" stems) and all trees marked with orange paint. Do not cut green marked trees.

Note: Do not cut trees marked with green paint.
