

Cutting Requirements



Oak/ Aspen Clearcut (45 ac)

Harvest all hardwood (including dead oak), jack pine and balsam fir greater than 4" dbh AND all pine and spruce marked with orange paint. Do not harvest white oak or unmarked red pine, white pine, or spruce (Do not harvest jack pine in north oak cutting unit – see map). No harvesting, skidding or road building from April 15th – October 15th.



Aspen Overstory Removal (8 ac)

Harvest all hardwood, balsam fir, and jack pine greater than 2" dbh. Do not harvest red pine, white pine, spruce or white oak. Use extreme care to protect existing young pines. Harvesting allowed ONLY on well frozen ground between October 15th – April 15th. No soil disturbance is allowed within harvest unit, including road building.



Jack Pine Overstory Removal (7 ac)

Harvest all jack pine, hardwood and balsam fir greater than 4" dbh. Do not harvest white oak, white pine, red pine, or spruce. Use extreme care to protect existing young aspen and jack pine. No harvesting, skidding or road building from April 15th – October 15th.



Red Pine Plantation Thinning (3 ac)

Harvest all trees marked with orange paint and all jack pine greater than 4" dbh. No harvesting, skidding or road building from April 15th – October 15th.


**Annosum treatment is required from April 1st to November 30th on conifer stumps throughout the entire sale.*
