

**Bagley Junction Timber Sale (TRACT 3810-5-14)** – Lump Sum Sale

Property: Peshtigo River State Forest

Location: Town of Porterfield (Sections 22 & 27, T31N, R22E), Marinette County

- ✓ 32 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
  - 40 cords aspen
  - 140 cords mixed hardwood
  - 420 cords scrub oak
- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2017
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between October 15<sup>th</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup>. Portions of roads and/ or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ During the open snowmobile season, trails must be kept passable and free of brush and debris.
- ✓ Invasive species BMPs must be followed to limit the spread of buckthorn.
- ✓ Harvest restrictions are as follows:
  - Within all cutting units harvesting, skidding and trucking can only occur between October 16<sup>th</sup> and April 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - Extremely dry or frozen ground conditions may be required in portions of the sale to prevent rutting.

**Black Bear Timber Sale (TRACT 3810-1-14)** – Mill Scale Sale

Location: Town of Stephenson (Sections 12 & 24, T33N, R18E), Marinette County

- ✓ 65 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
  - 1100 cords aspen
  - 70 cords red pine
  - 60 cords jack pine
  - 120 cords oak
  - 80 cords mixed hardwood
- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2017
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between October 1<sup>st</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup>. Portions of roads and/ or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ All damages to Old Veteran’s Lake Road and the existing forest road running south from Boat Landing 6 Road must be repaired prior to April 15<sup>th</sup> for the duration of the contract.
- ✓ Access to aspen and red pine cutting units is through private property, for which formal agreements have been established (see attached agreements)
- ✓ Annosum treatment is required on conifer stumps in pine plantations and aspen clearcut areas.
- ✓ Harvest restrictions are as follows:

- Within all cutting units harvesting and trucking can only occur between October 1<sup>st</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup>.

Location: Town of Stephenson (Sections 6, 7, & 8, T33N, R18E), Marinette County AND Town of Lakewood (Section 1, T33N, R17E), Oconto County

- ✓ 91 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
  - 970 cords aspen
  - 210 cords red pine
  - 40 cords spruce
  - 120 cords oak
  - 460 cords mixed hardwood
  - 18 MBF red oak logs
- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2017
- ✓ Roads and landings may only be built between July 15<sup>th</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup> in the bulk of the sale and only between October 31<sup>st</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup> in certain areas (see sale map for details). Portions of roads and/ or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post-harvest.
- ✓ Access to a portion of the sale may require crossing of a gas pipeline, for which, negotiations with the pipeline company are the responsibility of the contactor.
- ✓ Annosum treatment is required on conifer stumps within Red Pine Plantation and Pine Conversion cutting units.
- ✓ Harvest restrictions are as follows:
  - Harvesting, skidding and trucking can only occur between October 31<sup>st</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup> in certain cutting units (see sale map for details)
  - Harvesting, skidding and trucking can only occur between July 15<sup>th</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup> in certain cutting units (see sale map for details)

- ✓ 63 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
  - 280 cords aspen
  - 65 cords red pine

- 150 cords jack pine
- 575 cords scrub oak
- 35 cords mixed hardwood
- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2017
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between October 15<sup>th</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup>. Portions of roads and/ or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ Seeking out approved use of the private portion of Five Star Lane is at the discretion of the contractor.
- ✓ Annosum treatment is required on conifer stumps throughout the sale.
- ✓ Harvest restrictions are as follows:
  - Within all cutting units harvesting, road building and trucking can only occur between October 15<sup>th</sup> and April 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - Well frozen ground is required and no soil disturbance is allowed in the Aspen Overstory Removal cutting unit.

- ✓ 45 acres of timber stumpage with the following estimated volume:
  - 90 cords aspen
  - 210 cords red pine
  - 20 cords oak
  - 40 cords mixed hardwood
- ✓ The contract period will end July 1, 2017
- ✓ Roads and landings must be built between October 31<sup>st</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup>. Portions of roads and/ or trails may require seeding during sale and/ or post- harvest.
- ✓ Annosum treatment is required on conifer stumps throughout the sale.
- ✓ Access to west half of the sale requires use of USFS road
- ✓ Harvest restrictions are as follows:
  - Within all cutting units harvesting, road building and trucking can only occur between October 31<sup>st</sup> and March 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - Very dry or frozen ground conditions are required.
