

WEEB Wisconsin Environmental Education Board Announces Grant Program

The Wisconsin Environmental Education Board (WEEB), located at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, is seeking proposals for the 2013-2014 grant cycle. The Board anticipates awarding \$65,000 for general environmental education grants, \$55,000 for water education grants, \$90,000 for forestry grants, and \$90,000 for school forest grants. The WEEB thanks the Wisconsin Environmental Education Foundation and the 2013-2014 Water Grant Program funders - Wisconsin Energy Foundation, Madison Gas & Electric Foundation, and the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin- for their support this year.
