Implementation Proposal Steps

Our Process

1. Introduce the next DTR Recommendation to discuss and read Dr. Kroll's summary paragraph.
2. Address remaining questions or revisit visual aids as needed.
3. Group comments & alternative proposals.
4. Vote on proposals.
5. Recorder (Jim) reads proposal aloud should any corrections/additions need to be made.
6. Proposal is typed up & distributed electronically (Sam).
