At the first workshop, you were introduced to setting objectives and selecting options. Today you see three presentation that cover data that we use to assess the health of the salmon and trout populations and their prey. Dr. Mike Jones will then provide background on the Lake Michigan Decision Analysis model and show you representative outputs of different stocking strategies.

The goal for today is then to propose other strategies that can then be modeled. The results of all of those strategies will be presented at the third workshop for review. A subset of the strategies will then be selected for presentation at a public meeting to be held in summer 2012. The outcome of that meeting will be used to determine egg collection in the fall of 2012 and stocking numbers in 2013.
