Project Description

A "natural body of water" is defined in Wisconsin law as any spring, stream, pond, lake or wetland that was historically present in a natural state but may have been physically altered over time. A "freeze-out pond" is defined in Wisconsin law as a natural, self-contained body of water in which freezing or anoxic conditions prevent the body of water from naturally sustaining a fish population at least twice every 5 years.

Operating a fish farm in a Natural Body of Water requires a permit under NR 19, Wis. Adm. Code. I am applying for:

- NR 19 Permit Renewal** - for continued use of a natural waterbody that was previously permitted as a preexisting fish rearing facility or a freeze-out pond.
- Initial NR 19 Permit** - for new use of a natural waterbody for fish farming (note, the waterbody must be a freeze-out pond).
- Transfer of NR 19 Permit** - to convey an existing NR 19 permit from one party to another, as a result of change in ownership or leasehold interest of a fish farm.

5. For an Initial NR 19 Permit – Documentation to show the natural waterbody is a "freeze-out pond", meaning it is self-contained and has freezing or anoxic conditions that prevent a naturally-sustaining fish population at least twice every five years.
6. For a Transfer of NR 19 Permit – Photocopy of the previous owner's NR 19 permit, and documentation to show change of ownership.
7. Photocopy of any other permits or authorizations required by Ch. 30 or 31, Wis. Stats., the Army Corps of Engineers and any other federal, state or local laws and zoning ordinances for construction or operation of the fish farm. (Note: Permits issued under Ch. 30.19, 30.195 or 31.04 may mean your waterbody is exempt from a permit requirement.)
8. Photocopy of Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) Fish Farm Registration from current or previous year.

Note: If conditions 2, 3, and 7 are met, then the DNR may find that your fish farm is exempt from a Natural Waterbody permit requirement. If so, the DNR will return your application and notify you of this finding.





TRUST INDENTURE, DECLARATION
OF TRUST, MUTUAL & RECIPRO-
CAL AGREEMENTS (Cedar Springs Club)

And

Ernest Draheim, hereinafter called
Trustee.

Recites:

WHEREAS, the parties of the first part (MEMBERS), by proper deeds of conveyance duly executed and delivered, have conveyed to the said Ernest Draheim without any designation as "TRUSTEE", all their right, title and interest in and to the following lands in Oneida County, Wisconsin, and all buildings, improvements and personal property, to-wit:

The entire Northwest Quarter (NW-1/4) of Section One (1), and the Southwest Quarter (SW-1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE-1/4) of Section One (1), and the East half of the Northeast Quarter (E-1/2 NE-1/4) of Section Two (2), all in Township Thirty-Seven (37) North, Range Seven (7) East;

WHEREAS, the said Ernest Draheim has previously acquired tax deeds covering the above described premises, and deeds of conveyance from others formerly having or representing to have an interest in and to the premises above described;

WHEREAS, THE first parties (MEMBERS) have mutually agreed, one with the other, and collectively, that said real estate and all buildings, improvements and personal property thereon or thereto being longed, should be held in trust, since it was originally purchased for the purpose of providing fishing, hunting and other facilities, for the benefit of such first parties, emembers of their families, and guests, as hereinafter fully set out.

WHEREAS, the party of the second part, as TRUSTEE is recognized as the owner in fee simple of the above described premises, and that the first parties have an equitable interest as hereinafter set out, which should be recognized and declared,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS SEVERALLY AND MUTUALLY AGREED between the parties hereto, for themselves, their heirs, devisees and assigns as follows:

FIRST: DECLARATION OF TRUST - The party of the second part as TRUSTEE does hereby acknowledge and declare that all right, title and interest which he has acquired in and to the following described property in Oneida County, Wisconsin

The entire Northwest Quarter (NW¼) of Section One (1), and the Southwest Quarter (SW¼) of the Northeast quarter (NE¼) of Section One (1), and the East half of the Northeast Quarter (E½ NE¼) of Section Two (2), all in Township Thirty-Seven (37), North, Range Seven (7) East, shall be held by him as legal owner in fee simple, in which the equitable interests are hereinafter set out, and which property will be held, controlled and disposed of as authorized in this instrument.

SECOND: EQUITABLE INTEREST OF FIRST PARTIES - That the MEMBERS and each of them have an equitable interest in and to the above described property, with all building, improvements and personal property thereto belonging, fixed and determined as an undivided one-tenth interest each.

That the value of each of such undivided one-tenth interests have been fixed and determined at \$500.00 and each of the MEMBERS herein have paid to the TRUSTEE by proper credit or payment, the total sum of such interest.
