ATTENTION ARTISTS:

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources is happy to announce that the annual **Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest** has been reinstated and is now open and accepting entries! The winning art will appear on the 2017 Inland Trout Stamp.

The top 10 pieces of artwork will be selected from online voting in July 2016. Judging for the top 10 pieces of artwork for the Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest will be held in conjunction with the Inland Trout Stamp Design Contest and will take place in a closed session at the end of July 2016. The top three pieces of submitted artwork (that is, the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd-place entries) will be displayed at the **2016 Wisconsin State Fair** in West Allis, Wisconsin, from **Thursday, August 4th through Sunday, August 14th**. Artwork will be displayed within the Natural Resources Park in the southwest corner of the fairgrounds. **Please** be sure that your submitted artwork conforms to the specifications outlined in the "2017 Wisconsin Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest Rules." This is to maintain consistency among entries and to facilitate the temporary framing of the top three entries for display at the State Fair. **Also, please take note that entries should NOT be protected by any covering (such as acetate or cellophane); however, you may use an acetate envelope for protection during mailing so long as this envelope can be easily removed.**

In this document, you will find a copy of the "2017 Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest Reproduction Rights Agreement" and the "2017 Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest Rules". Please read over the instructions carefully. All paperwork can be included with your artwork during mailing, and you may mail entries and paperwork for Inland Trout Stamp and Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp design contests in the same package if you wish. **Entries will be accepted starting immediately and must be delivered or postmarked by July 1, 2016.**

2017 WISCONSIN GREAT LAKES SALMON AND TROUT STAMP DESIGN CONTEST RULES

I. CONTEST ELIGIBILITY:

Any person 18 years of age or older who is a United States citizen or legal permanent resident domiciled in the State of Wisconsin shall be eligible to submit an entry in the Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest. Only one (1) entry may be submitted by each contestant. Any member of the contest judging panel or any member of his or her immediate family is ineligible to enter.

II. CONTEST DATES:

Entries for the contest to select the design for the 2016 Wisconsin Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp will be accepted any time following this announcement, but must be received or postmarked no later than **July 1st, 2016**. Entries shall be submitted following submission procedures listed below in Section VII.

III. RESTRICTIONS OF SUBJECT MATTER:

Living species of salmon or trout commonly found in Wisconsin Great Lakes or appropriate subject matter relating to Great Lakes salmon or trout fishing must be the dominant feature of any design.

IV. ORIGINALITY OF ENTRY:

The submitted design must be the artist's own original creation and shall not be copied or duplicated in whole or in part from previously published art, including published photographs.

V. SUITABILITY OF ENTRY FOR REPRODUCTION:

Artists shall not be limited in the choice of colors or medium. The medium selected must be of permanent quality, such as pen and ink, oil, watercolor, etching, or pencil and should be rendered with full attention to tone, detail and anatomical accuracy. Photographs are not eligible. Metallic paints and fluorescent paints should not be used, as the printing process used to reproduce the actual stamps is not capable of reproducing metallic or fluorescent properties.

The artist should keep in mind that Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources lettering will appear on the finished stamp. Do NOT try to fit in the words on your entry, but DO keep some areas open to accommodate the lettering. The open areas can be light or dark in tone, but should be relatively free of any harsh contrasts from dark to light.

VI. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT FOR ENTRY:

The design shall be horizontal in the exact proportion of **6 1/2" high by 9" wide**. **Entries must be matted (over only) to a size no larger than 10" high and 12" wide**. No lettering or scroll work, including the artist's signature, is permitted on the front or back of the design itself. The only visible identification mark on each entry at the time of judging will be the letter code assigned to the entry by the contest coordinator.

VII. SUBMISSION PROCEDURES:

Every entry must be **mounted and affixed with white matting as described in Section VI above to the outside dimensions of 10" high by 12" wide**. Masonite board of 1/8-inch thickness with 1/8-inch matting is strongly recommended. **Entry may not exceed approximately 1/4-inch in total thickness**. No entry will be accepted that is in a wooden, metal, or plastic frame or that is under glass. Entries should not be protected by any covering (such as acetate or cellophane) as was previously required; however, an acetate envelope may be used for protection during mailing so long as the envelope can be easily removed.

The top one-half of the third page of the agreement form must be taped to the back of the entry. The bottom half is to be mailed with the entry along with the signed *Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest Reproduction Rights Agreement* certifying the originality of the entry and acknowledging the artist's acceptance of the terms and conditions governing the exclusive right of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources to reproduce the winning artwork. All entries will be processed by DNR based on the date of receipt. The contest coordinator will supervise the processing of entries, assign identification codes to each entry, set up displays for judging and supervise the return of all entries upon the completion of the contest.

VIII. PROPERTY INSURANCE FOR ENTRIES:

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources will not insure any entry it receives. All contestants are advised that it is their responsibility to obtain adequate property insurance for their respective entry, should they desire such protection. By submitting an entry, the artist agrees to hold DNR harmless against any damage, loss, or theft that may occur while DNR is in possession of the entry.

IX. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONTEST RULES:

Any entry that fails to comply with any of the requirements of the contest shall be disqualified and will not be considered by the judging panel. Such entries will be mailed back to the submitter within two weeks of the completion of contest judging.

X. SELECTION OF JUDGING PANEL:

There will be a panel of three (3) to five (5) judges appointed by the Trout Stamp Design Contest coordinator. The judges will be selected to provide a representative cross-section of individuals with expertise and an interest in trout and wildlife art. Judges selected will serve without compensation.

All qualifying entries will be displayed on the date of the judging and will be shown in chronological order based on the date they were received. The only visible identification mark on each entry will be the letter assigned to the entry by the contest coordinator, as well as the name of the species depicted. All artwork submitted will remain on display until judging is completed, and the top three pieces as determined by the judges will be displayed at the 2016 Wisconsin State Fair from August 4th through August 14th, 2016.

XI. DATE AND LOCATION OF THE CONTEST JUDGING:

Selection of the contest winner will take place at the end of July 2016 in a closed session (date to be announced). The judging will be held in conjunction with the 2016 Inland Trout Stamp Design Contests.

XII. JUDGING PROCEDURE AND SCORING:

All entries will be judged on anatomical accuracy, proper habitat setting, artistic composition and perspective, and suitability for reproduction. They should lend themselves to reproduction with the fullest possible attention to tone and detail.

The judging procedure will be as follows:

STEP 1: All entries meeting the design contest rules will be posted online in July. Each voter may nominate an unlimited number of entries for inclusion in the second step of the judging procedure. The top 10 pieces of artwork will move to the judging panel.

STEP 2: The judging panel will then rank the 10 "finalists," listing their choices from 1 (high, i.e. 1st place) to 10 (low, i.e. 10th place). The entry with the lowest total score shall be declared the first place winner.

In case of ties in Step 2, judges will re-judge only those entries tied for last place according to the procedures listed under that step. Scores in all steps of the judging procedure will be tabulated by the contest coordinator. The selection of the winning entry by the judges will be final. All

contestants will be notified of the name of the winning artist and design.

XIII. AWARDS

The first place winner will receive a special plaque of recognition and not more than ten (10) of the stamp reproductions created from their winning entry; additional copies of the stamp may be obtained at the artist's expense. The top three entries shall be displayed at the 2016 Wisconsin State Fair. The runners-up will receive a certificate of recognition.

XIV. TOP 10 ENTRIES:

Following the contest, DNR may hold the top ten (10) entries for publicity purposes for up to six (6) months, after which the entries will be returned to their respective artists. Entries outside of the top ten will be returned within two weeks following the contest judging.

XV. FUTURE CONTESTS:

All future Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contests will be held between March and July of each year.

2017 GREAT LAKES SALMON AND TROUT STAMP AND
PRINT REPRODUCTION RIGHTS AGREEMENT

I, _____ hereby submit an official entry ("entry") in the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources' Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Annual Contest for use during the license year beginning on April 1st, 2017 and ending on March 31st, 2018. By my signature, I enter into this agreement with the State of Wisconsin, Department of Natural Resources ("DNR"), and certify my understanding that the following statements are true and binding:

1. I have read, understand and agree to comply with the attached 2017 Wisconsin Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest Rules.
2. My entry is an original work of art of my own creation, and has not been copied or duplicated in whole or in part from previously published art, including past first-place entries to the DNR Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp Design Contest, paintings and drawings in any medium, and published photographs.
3. I am 18 years of age or older, domiciled in the State of Wisconsin, and am either a United States citizen or legal permanent resident.
4. I understand that DNR will not insure my entry against any damage, loss or theft. It is my responsibility to obtain adequate property insurance for my entry should I desire such protection.
5. I agree to hold DNR harmless against any damage, loss, or theft that may occur while DNR is in possession of my entry.
6. If my entry is among the top ten (10) entries in the contest, I grant DNR the right to retain my entry for a period not to exceed six (6) months from the date of judging, during which time my artwork may be publicly displayed or used for DNR promotional purposes, or otherwise retained for purposes of producing the 2017 Wisconsin Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp, and after which time DNR will return my entry to me.
7. I understand that I retain copyright on and ownership of my original entry, and that I may copy, reproduce, publish, or otherwise distribute my entry, subject only to the rights granted to DNR as part of this agreement.
8. I acknowledge that DNR has the exclusive right to produce the 2017 Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp using my winning artwork, which stamps may be sold or otherwise distributed solely by DNR or its designees.
9. If my entry is selected as the contest winner, I grant DNR the right to use reproductions, including photographs, of my entry and the 2017 Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp for promotional purposes as it deems useful and necessary, including those programs used in fundraising and contest promotion.
10. If my entry is selected as the contest winner, I understand that my name will not appear on the 2017 Great Lakes Salmon and Trout Stamp or reproduction plates used to print the stamp, and that the DNR logo and/or lettering may be added to the stamp and plates. However, all other reproductions of the winning entry made, caused to be made, or authorized by DNR under the terms of this agreement will identify the winning artist, and, if requested by the artist, display the artist's copyright notice.
11. Any or all stamps awarded by DNR as a prize in this contest are and shall be "artist edition" stamps and as such may not be used for the purpose of trout fishing nor sold to any other person for that purpose. The number of stamps awarded by DNR as a prize is limited to ten (10).
