

Pursuant to NR 1.02(7)(c), Wisconsin Administrative Code, the Department of Natural Resources gives public notice of the classification of 2.2 miles of Clark Creek, in Sauk County as a Class 1 Trout water. The segment of Clark Creek to be classified is located in the Town of Greenfield (T11N, R7E, Sects. 7,8,17), beginning at the intersection with the eastern border of Section 17 (NENE of Section 17) downstream to the first crossing of State Highway 113 (SENW of Section 7).

This classification is based upon a survey which indicates this portion of Clark Creek contains a self-sustaining population of brook trout. The stream contains spawning habitat and naturally produced fry, fingerling, and yearling fish in sufficient numbers to utilize the available trout habitat.

The Department shall waive any hearing requirement on this classification unless a written request for hearing is received before October 31, 2015. Requests should be sent to:
