7 Steps to a Safer Home Ignition Zone



Remove pine needles and leaves from roof and gutters.



Rake debris from under deck and around wood fences.



Keep lawn clean and green. Rake 30 feet around buildings.



Remove tree branches that overhang the roof.



Move firewood 30 feet away from buildings.



Prune dead branches off trees and shrubs



Remove branches of evergreen trees up to a height of 6-10 feet.
