

Woodboro State Wildlife Area Dispersed Camping

- Dispersed camping is allowed in four sites as shown on the accompanying map, plus mowed parking areas, and in front of berms and stones used to close logging trails.
- Those camping in parking lots are asked to camp further back in the lot to allow parking room for other hunters. They are not parking in your campsite—you are camping in their parking area.
- All sites are “first come, first served.”
- Do not block gates or you will be towed.
- Camping is allowed between September 1 and December 31.
- Camping is limited to 10 consecutive days.
- Camping permits are not required.
- All garbage must be packed out.
- Do not cut any living trees or shrubs.
- Drinking water and rest room facilities are not provided.
- The roads will not be plowed or otherwise serviced to accommodate campers.

This is an experimental program. Failure to comply with these rules will result in the loss of camping privileges for everyone.
