Facilities, when present, may provide a relatively high level of user comfort, convenience and environmental protection</li> </ul> <p><u>Recreation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>fishing</li> <li>walking</li> <li>jogging</li> <li>biking</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>MASTER PLAN OBJECTIVES</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Non-Recreation Mtg.</p>	<p><u>Type 4 Recreational Use – Non-Recreational Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any land or vegetation management prescription or method that supports the master plan’s management objectives for the area and is consistent with the site’s ecological capability may be used.</li> <li>• Resource management developments such as dams, dikes, ditches, habitat improvement devices, and constructed ponds and other types of non–recreational structures, that harmonize with the surrounding landscape to the degree practicable and feasible may be present</li> <li>• Visual quality management techniques shall be prescribed, to the degree feasible and practicable, as appropriate for the specific management objectives, resource capabilities, and the degree and type of aesthetic concern for the area.</li> </ul> <p><u>Vegetation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Approx. five acres of native short grass prairie</li> <li>• Approx. one acre of upland trees and shrubs</li> <li>• Remainder of vegetation will be managed in a mowed and manicured manner.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Accomplishments 2013</b></p>	<p><i>Acre of shrubs/trees never planted - prevented by agreement with city when park built.</i></p> <p><i>Weed control in prairies on-going in 2013 – spot spraying, pulliong, cutting and dead-heading</i></p>
