## Whitewater Oak Opening Workday



**Get outside and cut and burn up buckthorn at Whitewater Oak Opening SNA.** Help volunteers during our monthly Southern Kettle Moraine SNA workdays on the second Saturday. Protect some majestic oaks in the process. Buckthorn can spread and shade out savanna plants at this site. We will have fires going if there is snow. Bring a bag lunch to eat afterwards. No skills needed you will be trained onsite.

**Date:** December 10, 2016

**Time:** 9am-noon

**Directions:** From Whitewater take Co Hwy P south past Hwy 12 and Kettle Moraine Drive. Take the fourth entrance lane on the left (east). Watch for a sign directing you.

**What to wear:** Dress for the weather and wear clothes that are OK to get beat up. There may be fires throwing burning embers into the air. Wear clothes that can get holes in them.

**What to bring:** Loppers (optional), bag lunch (optional)

**If the workday is cancelled due to weather conditions, a message will be left at 262-441-0393 at least two hours prior to the event. If there is no cancellation message, the workday will continue as scheduled.**
