

Pet Friendly Hiking Areas



Pets are allowed **on-leash** on the trails listed below:

- Butler Lake Trail Loop (3.1 mi)
- Greenbush Loop Trail System (9 mi)
(Not when snow is present--designated ski trail.)
- Ice Age National Scenic Trail (31 mi)
- New Fane Loop Trail System (5.5 mi)
(Not when snow is present--designated ski trail.)
- Parnell Tower Trail Loop (3.5 mi)
- Zillmer Loop Trail System (8 mi)
(Not when snow is present--designated ski trail.)

Pets are prohibited on marked nature trails at all times; these include Mauthe Lake's Tamarack, Long Lake's Summit, Ice Age Center's Moraine and Spruce Lake Bog Nature Trails.


Pet Picnic Areas

There are designated pet picnic areas located at Mauthe Lake and Long Lake Recreation Areas. (See Forest map for exact locations.)

The Forest has adopted the Carry In/Carry Out program. Picnickers are required to take home any garbage and/or recyclables they generate (including pet waste).

Dog Training Areas

The forest has two areas designated as “dog training” areas. A wet dog training area where dogs can be trained in water skills. A dry dog training area where dogs can be trained in upland bird skills.



(Note: NR17.8 “Dog training” means the activity of teaching a dog to retrieve, point, flush, and/or track game for the purpose of hunting or dog trail competition.)
