


ATV, UTV, OHM and Dirt Bike Trail Information and Rules

Richard Bong State Recreation Area (RBSRA) 26313 Burlington Road, Kansasville, WI 53139

GENERAL RULES

1. **Call 262-878-5600** before you come to the park (the same day) to hear the daily message about trail availability. Availability of trails may change (same day) if conditions change.
2. Hours of operation are 9:00 a.m. to sunset.
3. Do not operate at improper speeds. The speed limit on the beginners' loop is 10 mph.
4. Riders must slow to 10 mph or less riding within 100 feet of a person on foot.
5. Stay on marked trails. Trails are generally flat with many sharp turns. Trails are one-way unless marked two-way.
6. ALL ATVs, UTVs, OHMs, or dirt bikes must have U.S. Forest Service approved spark arrester with muffler not exceeding 96 decibels.
7. Any vehicle bringing ATVs, UTVs, OHMs or dirt bikes into RBSRA must have a valid daily or annual state park vehicle admission sticker. You may purchase stickers at the park office or at the self-registration station. Failure to purchase a sticker or self-register may result in a citation.
8. During pheasant hunting season (fall) all trails are closed each day until 2 p.m.
9. Unloading of ATVs, UTVs, OHMs or dirt bikes is permitted in the trail parking lot. If the lot is full, unload ATVs, UTVs, OHMs or dirt bikes in the lot then park in Lot E on the other side of the road.
10. Operation on gravel service roads, the runway, any road, campgrounds or in parking lots is prohibited and may result in a citation.
11. While in the campgrounds, ATVs, UTVs, OHMs and dirt bikes must remain on the trailer/truck bed.
12. Dune buggies, go carts, or other off-road vehicles (including trucks) are not permitted on the trails.

OHM AND DIRT BIKE RULES

1. All OHM operators that are at least 12 years old and born after Jan. 1, 1998, must have completed OHM Safety certification to operate an OHM on areas open to the public for recreational use.
2. All OHMs must be registered with the DNR.
3. All Dirt Bike riders must wear a helmet.

ATV/ RULES

1. All riders born after Jan. 1, 1988 must possess an ATV Safety Education Certificate except riders under age 12 riding on an ATV 90cc or less must be accompanied by a legal guardian.
2. All riders under age 18 must wear a helmet.
3. All ATVs must be registered in Wisconsin. Non-residents must purchase an ATV Trail Pass if the ATV is not registered in Wisconsin. The ATV Trail Pass is not sold at RBSRA.
4. ATVs up to 48 inches wide, weighing up to 900 pounds with 3 or 4 low pressure tires and a seat that can be straddled, are allowed on the trails
5. All ATVs required to register for Public Use shall have a plate attached to the rear of the vehicle displaying the registration ID number.

UTV RULES

1. **Advisory:** UTVs with a width between 51 and 65 inches may not fit on RBSRA trails.
2. A rider must be 16 or older to operate a UTV.
3. No person may operate a UTV unless each passenger has their seat belt properly fastened.
4. All UTVs required to register for Public Use shall have a plate attached to the rear of the vehicle displaying the registration ID number.
