


Wildcat Mountain State Park

Group Camping Units	
Group Site A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -accommodates up to 25 tent campers -all wooded site
Group Site B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -accommodates up to 25 campers in tents or small-wheeled campers -site not recommended for large-wheeled camping units -partially wooded
Group Site C	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -accommodates up to 50 campers -appropriate for all sizes of camping units -open grassy area with shade trees
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Drinking water is available from a portable water tank. *Each site has picnic tables and a fire ring. *There are no electrical hook-ups. *Please recycle your refuse into the appropriate bin. *The 32 x 20-foot shelter is to be shared by all three group campsites.
