

Wisconsin DNR Trail News 07/02/2008
There is one news item in this edition.

1. Update on Wisconsin State Park System (WSPS) Properties Affected by Flooding

- Devil's Lake State Park is open but portions of trails are still closed. Parfrey's Glen State Natural Area remains closed.
- Military Ridge State Trail is open except at the second box culvert approximately 2 miles west of the City of Verona.
- Governor Dodge State Park horse campground and trails are closed (14 sites) and the bike trails are closed.
- Rocky Arbor State Park is open to camping through the reservation system as of July 1st.
- Wildcat Mountain State Park will open to family and horse camping on July 3rd (along with the canoe landing). The road to enter the park is passable and the park is currently open to picnicking and trails (some areas are still closed off).
- The 400 State Trail is open from Elroy – Wonewoc but the Wonewoc – Reedsburg portion will need bridge repairs and cannot be opened in the short-term.
- The Elroy-Sparta, LaCrosse River, and Great River State Trails are all open.
- Merrick State Park is open.

Any properties not listed may still have flooding along trails and campsites but otherwise are open for business as usual.
