Why are we planning amendments for these properties?

An upcoming amendment to the Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest master plan is being planned to address future management of recently acquired acreage. An amendment is also being planned for the Willow Flowage Scenic Waters Area to address increased public interest in additional road access. Master Plans are designed to guide resource management on state lands in compliance with Chapter NR 44 of Wisconsin Administrative Code.
