¹ Approximately 87% balsam fir, 11% black spruce, and 2% hemlock. Includes 6 MBF black spruce sawtimber and a few white spruce and cedar.

² Includes a few balsam poplar trees.

³ Approximately 78% sugar maple, 12% red maple, 4% white birch, 3% basswood, 2% yellow birch, and 1% black ash. Includes 22MBF sugar maple, 10MBF basswood, 6MBF white birch, 4MBF red maple, and a few ironwood, elm, and cherry trees.

Special Conditions:

- 1. Harvest operations are only allowed in Zone A from freeze-up until January 15. Logging operations for the rest of the sale area including hauling will only be allowed from August 1 to February 1.**
- 2. No new soil disturbance or stump pulling is allowed within or directly around the grass opening as shown on the timber sale map.**
3. Cutting must be concurrent for all species including non-merchantable trees where designated.
4. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
- 5. The main gated woods road off of Cedar Lake Circle and through the sale must be kept in good shape at all times. Private property owners on Cedar Lake have an easement for this road and it must remain in drivable condition by passenger vehicles.**
6. Slash must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10' behind the tree line along all roads and trails concurrently with cutting.
7. Whole tree utilization or biomass harvesting is not allowed.
8. The snowmobile trail must remain free of debris, snow covered during winter, and left in good condition at all times.
- 9. Short-wood forwarding only within the Northern Hardwood Thinning.**



Area 1 Winegar Moraines Forest Production and Area 9 Hemlock Hardwood Native Community

-  Northern Hardwood Thinning (180 acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, black spruce, and orange marked trees. Do not damage residual trees.
-  Aspen/Balsam Fir Regeneration Area (40 acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, black spruce, maple, basswood, ironwood, and orange marked trees. Cut all 1-5" aspen, white birch, maple, and ironwood concurrently.
-  Northern Hardwood Regeneration Area (33 acres): Cut all aspen, white birch, balsam fir, black spruce, maple, basswood, ironwood, black ash, and orange marked trees. Cut all 2-5" maple and ironwood concurrently.
