# Legislation and Rulemaking

- Act 333 – DNR can choose to waive state statutory tipping fees if it will facilitate voluntary waste removal to prevent environmental contamination. Limited use anticipated.
- NR 150 – In effect 4/1/14. Revamps WEPA implementation to eliminate need for redundant or pro forma written analyses, to focus on those analyses that add value to decisionmaking. No EA for minor, routine actions, actions that have an equivalent analysis process, or actions for which there is a functionally equivalent analysis already written.

# E-Cycle Wisconsin

- May 7 Stakeholder Meeting – About 65 collectors, recyclers and others provided feedback on program, networked and learned from each other. Clarified roles within shared responsibility program; identified upcoming challenges.
- Forthcoming guidance will indicate E-Cycle Wisconsin will not regard CRT glass used in landfill disposal or for alternate daily cover as “recycled” and eligible to meet manufacturer recycling targets.

# EPA Update on NSPS Rules

- CCR (coal utility ash) rule – final rule expected to be signed by Dec 2014 – no plans to share prior drafts
- RD&D rule revision – EPA Hdqtrs is working on it, not a priority, proposed rule will be subject to public comment period, etc.
- NHSM rule 40 CFR 241 – add'l mat'ls – 3/25/14
  - C& D wood
  - RR ties – creosote-treated
  - Paper recycling residuals at on-site mills w/boilers
- MSW Lf NSPS rules – continuing updates & clarifications
