

## Appendix II

### Prominent Exotic Plant and Animal Species

#### TREES

- **Common Buckthorn** (*Rhamnus cathartica*) – occurs in forests, prairies, and disturbed areas.
- **Glossy Buckthorn** (*Rhamnus frangula*) – occurs in forest and wetlands.

#### SHRUBS

- **Tatryan Honeysuckle** (*Lonicera tatarica*) – occurs in forests, savannas, and prairies.
- **Showy Bush Honeysuckle** (*Lonicera x bella*) – occurs in forests, savannas, and prairies.
- **Multiflora Rose** (*Rosa multiflora*) – occurs along fencelines, forest edges, savannas, prairies and pastures.

#### VINES

- **Everlasting Pea** (*Lathyrus latifolius*) – occurs in disturbed areas.

#### FORBS

- **Garlic Mustard** (*Allaria petiolata*) – occurs in forests.
- **Spotted Knapweed** (*Centaurea maculosa*) – occurs in disturbed areas, prairies, and dunes.
- **Canada Thistle** (*Cirsium arvense*) – occurs in prairies and disturbed areas.
- **Helliborine** (*Epipactis helliborine*) – occurs in forests and disturbed areas.
- **Common St. John's-wort** (*Hypericum perforatum*) – occurs in prairies and dunes.
- **Yellow water flag** (*Iris pseudocorus*) – occurs in wetlands.
- **Bird's-foot trefoil** (*Lotus corniculatus*) – occurs in prairies.
- **Purple Loosestrife** (*Lythrum salicaria*) – occurs in wetlands.
- **White Sweet Clover** (*Melilotus alba*) – occurs in prairies.
- **Yellow Sweet Clover** (*Melilotus officinalis*) – occurs in prairies.
- **Wild Parsnip** (*Pastinaca sativa*) – occurs in prairies.
- **Japanese Knotweed** (*Polygonum cuspidatum*) – occurs in forests.
- **Field Sorrel** (*Rumex acetosella*) – occurs in disturbed areas.
- **Tansy** (*Tanacetum vulgare*) – occurs in disturbed areas and prairies.
- **Leafy Spurge** (*Euphorbia esula*) – occurs in openings, roadsides and pastures

#### GRASSES

- **Reed Canary Grass** (*Phalaris arundinacea*) – occurs in wetlands.
- **Giant Reed Grass** (*Phragmites australis*) – occurs in wetlands.

#### AQUATIC Plants

- **Common Forget –Me-Not** (*Phalaris arundinacea*)
- **Eurasian Water Milfoil** (*Myriophyllum spicatum*) - occurs in wetlands

- **Curly Leafed Pond Weed** (*Potamogeton crispus*)

- **Carp** (*Cyprinus carpio*) – Green Bay, Lake Michigan, and tributaries; inland lakes
- **Sea Lamprey** (*Petromyzon marinus*) – Green Bay, Lake Michigan, and tributaries
- **Alewife** (*Alosa pseudoharengus*) – Green Bay, Lake Michigan
- **Rainbow Smelt** (*Osmerus mordax*) – Green Bay, Lake Michigan
- **Round Goby** (*Neogobius melanostomus*) – Green Bay, Lake Michigan
- **European Rudd** (*Scardinius erythrophthalmus*) – Green Bay
- **White Perch** (*Morone americana*) – Green Bay, Lake Michigan
