Upcoming Deadlines

November

SFY 19 CWFP Funding List published.

End of December / Start of January

SFY 2020 CWFP & SDWLP Project Priority Lists (PPLs) published.

January / February 2019

SFY 19 CWFP project priority score objections deadline (30 days after the PPL is published).

January 31, 2019

Last recommended date for opening bids on SFY 19 SDWLP projects.

February 27, 2019*

SFY 18 CWFP final loan closing date (for Principal Forgiveness & non-PF projects).

*For both PF & non-PF CWFP applications, the loan closing must be within eight (8) months of the date of the application acceptance notification; sent by the end of the state fiscal year for which the Intent to Apply (ITA)/Priority Evaluation & Ranking Formula (PERF) is valid. The loan closing date is normally the second or fourth Wednesday of the month.

Annual Discount Rate Update for Cost-Effective Analysis

All wastewater facilities plans require a cost-effective analysis to ensure that only the minimum resources required (monetary, environmental, and social) are expended over the 20-year planning period. The most cost-effective alternative, when considering all resources, must be selected; differences between alternatives within approximately 10% are considered equivalent. This is separate from the user rate analysis.

To account for opportunity costs over the planning period, monetary costs are compared as total present cost or uniform annual cost. The DNR has updated the discount rate for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2019 facilities plans to **3.625%**, which should be used until the rate's annual update occurring in October 2019.
