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## SFY 2020 Project Priority Lists

### Safe Drinking Water Loan Program (SDWLP)

As outlined in the SFY 2019 SDWLP Intended Use Plan (IUP), the department streamlined the Priority Evaluation and Ranking Formula (PERF) scoring process. Eligible projects are listed on the [State Fiscal Year \(SFY\) 2020 SDWLP Project Priority List \(PPL\)](#) reflecting the self-scores as submitted by potential loan applicants. If your municipality appears on the PPL and you wish to pursue funding, review the following documents:

### SDWLP PERF score reevaluation requests

If you have new or additional information that will potentially modify your project's PERF score, please submit the materials with an explanation to Nicole Mathews, SDWLP Coordinator, at [Nicole.Mathews@wisconsin.gov](mailto:Nicole.Mathews@wisconsin.gov).

Reevaluation requests can be submitted up to 45 days after the June 30<sup>th</sup> SDWLP application deadline. They will be reviewed, in the order they are received, after the June 30<sup>th</sup> deadline.

### Clean Water Fund Program (CWFP)

We anticipate publishing the SFY 2020 CWFP PPL at the end of February or the start of March. Notification will be emailed when the PPL is posted to the [Project Lists and Intended Use Plans \(IUPs\)](#) webpage. ### CWFP PERF score objections & reevaluations

After publication of the CWFP PPL, you have 30 days to submit a PERF score objection and provide any **new** information that was **unavailable at the time** of the ITA/PERF submittal.

If there is no new information but you have supporting documentation that **was not included** with the ITA/PERF submittal **and** you submit an eligible application for the project, you may request a PERF score reevaluation after the application submittal deadline. Your reevaluation request must be submitted within 30 days of the application submittal deadline.

Submit PERF score objections and reevaluation requests with supporting documentation to [Matt Marcum](#), CWFP coordinator.

### End of February / Start of March

SFY 2020 CWFP Project Priority List (PPL) published.

### March / April 2019

SFY 19 CWFP project priority score objections deadline (30 days after the PPL is published).

### February 27, 2019

SFY 18 CWFP final loan closing date (for Principal Forgiveness & non-PF projects).

### March 31, 2019

Executed construction contracts due for SFY 19 SDWLP projects.

### April 30, 2019

Last recommended date for opening bids on SFY 19 CWFP projects.

### May 2, 2019

ALL required documentation due for SFY 19 SDWLP projects.
