All original wooden decking will be replaced with pressure treated wood. Existing accessories will be removed and then re-installed. Thirty slips will be designated as transient slips.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Replace original wood decking of A, B, C, and D docks with pressure treated wood. • Remove and re-install all accessories such as utility pedestals, cleats and bumpers. • Thirty slips will be designated as transient slips • The transient slips will be in excess of 26' in length, clearly marked as transient slips, and spread throughout the four docks.

With the two docks there will be a total of 4 slips designated for transient boaters. Each dock will be 50 feet long and 6 feet wide. The project will be ADA accessible.

DNR:MILWAUKEE	Lakeshore State Park Transient Docks		SE	\$123,000.00	\$41,000.00	Lakeshore State park will develop a water supply system that will provide hose bibs to the slips, as well as support the boater and visitor restroom/shower facilities at the transient dock slip area. This will increase summer user rates at the docks from 14% to 80%.
IRON COUNTY	Saxon Harbor Marina Reconstruction, 2018	Iron	NO	\$181,439.00	\$61,203.20	Iron County will reconstruct a harbor of refuge and increase dockage, complete designs, engineering and permitting, install one dry hydrant, reconstruct one harbor master office, upgrade electrical pedestals, lighting along the east wall and seawall, add WiFi, install a sign layout to identify transient docking locations, upgrade the existing fueling station, add kiosks for transient payments, reconstruct one marina bathroom and shower, reconstruct the east wall.
