Dear Mr. Goodwin,

Thank you for your efforts to understand, protect, and improve the Red Cedar Lakes! This letter is to notify you that the Aquatic Plant Management (APM) Plan dated October 2019, meets the criteria under Administrative Code NR 198.43 and thus the DNR has approved the APM Plan.

Approved management activities in the plan and outlined below are eligible for funding under Lake Management Planning and Aquatic Invasive Species grants subject to the application requirements of those programs.

Approved management recommendations include the following:

1. AIS prevention and monitoring activities
2. Species-specific AIS monitoring and management activities provided they meet DNR guidelines and Administrative Code requirements
3. Educational activities including AIS, lake stewardship and leadership, aquatic plants, shoreline health, etc.

Please note: Aquatic plant control for the purposes of nuisance relief or navigation are *not* eligible grant activities, and the Department reserves the right to inspect nuisance or navigation conditions prior to permitting the treatment of aquatic plants.

Thanks to you and the lake community for continuing your efforts to protect and improve the Red Cedar Lakes.
