On July 12, 1999 the above named site was reviewed by the South Central Region Closure Committee to determine whether the case qualified for No Further Action under s. NR 708.09, Wis. Adm. Code. This committee reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in case closure.

Based on the information provided to the Department, the Closure Committee has determined that no additional investigation or cleanup actions as required in ch. NR 708, Wis. Adm. Code, are necessary at this time.

However, please be aware that this case may be reopened pursuant to s. NR 726.09, Wis. Adm. Code, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, or welfare or the environment.
