Subject: D & L Site Haz Waste Requirements

Kristin,

I don't know all the details, but I know from others that a similar process, soil treat to reduce PCE and TCE was performed at the D & L site in Menomonee Falls. On that site, one sample per box was tested, TCLP only, and if it passed, it was OK to accept at the subtitle D facility. Waste Management was the landfill.

I have also had other sites where TCLP is the key for landfill acceptance, and one sample per box that the consultant feels is representative has been acceptable. Projects were done for drycleaners in 2009, 2012, 2013, using similar soil and chemical mixing processes as this.

Not sure if something has changed in the department, I don't think from a federal regulatory wise anything is different, but it would appear a much higher level of documentation is being required at the Bay Towel site versus other sites.
