Re: Notification of Five Year Review Start for the WPSC Camp Marina MGP Superfund Alternative Site Sheboygan, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin

Dear Mr. Feeney:

This letter is to notify you that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) will begin the Five Year Review for the WPSC Camp Marina MGP Superfund Alternative Site (Site) located in Sheboygan, Wisconsin on October 29, 2021.

EPA is conducting a statutory Five Year Review for the Site as required by Section 121 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), as amended by the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986 (SARA). The purpose of the review is to evaluate the remedy implemented at the Site and determine if the remedy will be protective of human health and the environment.

The Five Year Review for the Site is due on September 22, 2022. EPA is providing the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) with notification so EPA and WDNR can begin the necessary coordination activities. EPA is working with the Community Involvement Coordinator to notify the public of the review.
