Wisconsin Public Service Corporation (WPSC) is providing this monthly progress report for the WPSC Former Green Bay Manufactured Gas Plant (MGP) Site.

1) PROGRESS MADE DURING THE PAST MONTH

- Prepared and submitted September 2022 Monthly Progress Report to United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) by October 15, 2022.
- Submitted a Dewatering Treatment and Monitoring Plan and Permit Application to NEW
 Water and the City of Green Bay on August 5, 2022 to secure a permit to discharge to the
 publicly owned treatment works, and to receive pre-treatment discharge limits for the Early
 Removal Action. NEW Water issued Limited Term Wastewater Discharge Permit No. LTP1022-1 on October 21, 2022.
- Received USEPA comments verbally September 7, 2022 on Responses to Comment on Former Green Bay MGP Early Removal Action Work Plan (RAWP) Revision 0 and RAWP, Revision 1 that were submitted on August 17, 2022. Submitted elements of the RAWP Revision 2 on September 26, 2022 and USEPA indicated there were no further comments on October 12, 2022.
- Submitted to WDNR on September 26, 2022 additional requested information on the secondary containment for the planned groundwater treatment system per an email request from Richard Douglas received August 29, 2022. WDNR e-mail correspondence to Ramboll on October 11, 2022 indicated the specifications were sufficient to meet the department's concern about spill control for untreated waste.
- Continued weekly sheen inspections of the cove area of OU2, located at the end of Utility Court.

2) ANALYTICAL AND OTHER TESTING RESULTS RECEIVED

 Received OU2 operations and maintenance bathymetric survey of the South Focus Area October 21, 2022. Results will be provided in an Operations and Maintenance Summary Memorandum once North Focus Area survey results are received.
