The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) considers General Motors (GM) Sediment Contamination closed. No further investigation or remediation is required at this time. Provide this letter to anyone who purchases this property from you.

This final closure decision is based on the correspondence and data provided and is issued under Wis. Adm. Code ch. NR 726. The South Central Region (SCR) Closure Committee reviewed the request for closure on March 19, 2020. The DNR reviews environmental remediation cases for compliance with state laws and standards to maintain consistency in the closure of these cases.

This 1.5-acre sediment site in the Rock River, located at a storm sewer outfall that conveys surface drainage from the former General Motors Assembly Plant, contained sediment with elevated levels of polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, heavy metals and polychlorinated biphenyls. The site was remediated by dredging the contaminated sediment from the river. A sand cover was used to restore the dredged area. Dewatered sediment was managed under an approved material management plan. The site is located in the Rock River offshore of the street end of Park Ave., north of West Delevan Dr., in the vicinity of 42.668141 degrees latitude and -89.023198 degrees longitude. The site was investigated and remediated in accordance with the regulations under Wis. Adm. Code chs. NR 700-754.

Please be aware that the case may be reopened pursuant to Wis. Adm. Code, § NR 727.13, if additional information regarding site conditions indicates that contamination on or from the site poses a threat to public health, safety, or welfare or to the environment.
