Eric, thank you for the updated drawing. Matt and I discussed, and the plan that we would like to proceed with is as follows:

- W19 Abandon
- W33 No impacts except sidewalk removal, well can remain in place
- W39 Abandon
- W22 No impacts we can keep this well location.
- W40 Move east due to proposed driveway. This will be a flush mount well
- W26 Relocate to north side of sidewalk, rather than between curb and south side of sidewalk. Recommend this be a stick-up well.
- W29 Relocate to north side of sidewalk, rather than between curb and south side of sidewalk. Recommend this be a stick-up well.

Regarding locating flush mount wells in the future, TRC can assist the City in locating these wells, and then what is typically done as work is performed around them, is to place cones and/or barrels over the wells to alert equipment operators of their presence.
