The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has received and reviewed the Groundwater Sampling Report and No Further Action Request (Report) prepared by OBG dated May 21, 2018 and updated December 12, 2018 for the Burnham Canal Superfund Alternative Site (Site). The report documents groundwater sampling that was completed to characterize groundwater quality downgradient of the wire reclamation furnace area.

Three monitoring wells were installed and sampled twice for dissolved copper, dissolved lead and polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs). None of the samples exceeded any current groundwater standards for the parameters tested.

The DNR concurs that the site investigation for groundwater related to the wire reclamation furnace area is complete and that no further action related to groundwater for this Site is necessary at this time. The monitoring wells may be abandoned.
