Also, after reviewing the recently submitted 2018 Annual Report, I wanted to comment on the proposed work for 2019. Regarding the treatment systems and assessing vapor intrusion potential, it is highly encouraged to review Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 700; guidance publication RR-800, RR-042 and RR-986. Assessment of potential vapor intrusion at the Nor-Lake facility should be addressed through soil gas sampling and sub-slab sampling. While stack test sampling is useful data, the Department would not use this data to evaluate potential vapor intrusion at the site nor would it be considered to move the site towards closure.
