I agree with all of the newly proposed downgradient boring locations. It appears that you are proposing to collect soil samples at the soil/water interface as well as the groundwater samples at each of the proposed downgradient boring locations from the following areas: 1) 1997 fuel spill area; 2) AFFF Test Area; 3) Former airport fire station, and; 4) 2001 crash site. Considering the downgradient location of these borings I believe the proposed groundwater samples would be more valuable and I would suggest forgoing the soil samples at these locations. Please proceed with the outlined scope of work.
