The push-ahead sampler assembly is approximately 2 feet long and will be advanced ~1 foot beyond the bottom of the drill casing. The exposed screen is only about 1 foot in length. So, for example, at the 70' target sample interval, we'll likely collect it in a 1-foot interval in the ~69-72' interval, depending on exactly where bottom of the casing is at the end of the soil sampling run. The goal is to collect three groundwater profiling samples on 10-foot spacing and use the results to select the screened interval for the MW-06-Deep well.
