Evan,

Thanks again for meeting earlier this month, we appreciated the discussion. Dave and I discussed what the next step should be for the site and decided that submittal of a remedial action options report would be the most appropriate way to summarize the field work and conclusions drawn from updating the conceptual site model. The options report should outline constraints or implications associated with at least the following remedies: targeted source zone removal, groundwater pump and treat, surfactant flushing, and monitored natural attenuation. In the past, other options such as permeable reactive barriers and oxidative injections have been reviewed- these do not have be included in this updated remedial action options report. The goal for this updated report should be to summarize our discussions over the past year in a manner than the Department can directly respond to and set the site on a path toward closure.
