On behalf of the City of La Crosse, I am requesting an extension to the Department's timeframe for submitting the workplan for additional site investigation. In your November 22, 2022 notice-to-proceed letter you required submitting a work plan and schedule for additional site investigation within 30 days, which is January 15, 2023 and which falls on a Sunday. We would like an additional month in order to inform and obtain feedback and concurrence from City decision-making bodies, to identify a funding source and secure legislation authorizing funding. While the topic is slated to proceed through the committee cycle culminating in the City Council meeting on the evening of February 9, the funding source has not yet been identified. Thus, we respectfully request an extension to February 15, 2022. Given the potential challenges of identifying a funding source and securing governing board approval, we wish note that we may need to ask for an additional month into mid-March.
